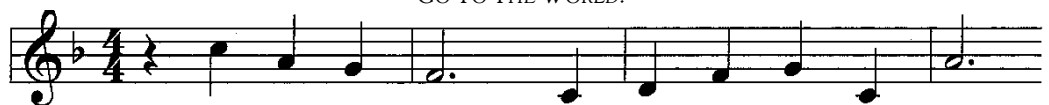

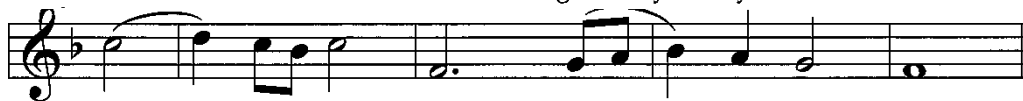



Vardiman moved to Allegany county, serving Ellerslie, Frostburg, Centenary, and Zion United Methodist Churches. She was also a staff chaplain at the former Western Maryland Health System. Rev. Vardiman retired in 2017, becoming an Earthkeeper in the UMC, focusing on creation care and education about the environment. She is also helping to form a Braver Angels chapter in Allegany County. She is married to Nelson Cleavenger.
